


SPORTING OPPORTUNITIES

LCS aims to provide a range of sporting opportunities for our students. Our focus is on participation, sportsmanship and being a great Christian witness in the different competitions that we enter. LCS teams compete hard to get good results but that is not our main focus.

Sports involvement in Year 7-12 falls under 2 different organisations. NSATIS (Northern Sports Association for Independent Schools Tasmania) and NHSSA (Northern High Schools Sports Association).

Most sporting costs are covered by the school but students are expected to provide sport specific equipment such as boots and shin pads for soccer. Uniforms are available to be loaned from the library.



SATIS/NSATIS INFORMATION

Commitment & Organisation

PLEASE NOTE: All sports require team members to be committed to the team. Commitment means being organised and attending training and games. This includes having a positive attitude. Full season rosters are available for all NSATIS sports so you can alert your workplace of times when you won't be able to work. Given that a number of Year 10-12 students have casual work we ask that you are vigilant and organised when it comes to your personal schedule.

Some students are also involved and committed to other sporting teams and NSATIS could clash with trainings that your club holds. We ask that you do the same thing with your sporting club and let them know of times when you are required to play games for LCS.


The SATIS website (google SATIS) is a great resource for information about the sports that SATIS/NSATIS offer. SATIS is the statewide sporting organisation for Independent schools. LCS will be mainly involved in NSATIS matches which means our teams will mainly compete against Grammar, Scotch, St. Pats, Marist and St. Brendan's Shaw.

If LCS is successful in winning a NSATIS Snr. 1sts title then students will compete against the top Southern school for the SATIS title. In 2018 the LCS Snr. Girls Soccer team was successful in winning the NSATIS and SATIS Snr 1sts soccer titles – an amazing achievement! Our Senior 1sts Badminton and Table Tennis teams also won the NSATIS titles!

2021 will be our 6th year in NSATIS and as well as involvement in the traditional 3 LCS carnivals (Swimming, Cross Country and Athletics) LCS also offers other sporting options.

NHSSA INFORMATION


The NHSSA website (google NHSSA) is a resource for information about the sports that NHSSA offer. NHSSA organise sporting fixtures for High Schools in Northern Tasmania. NHSSA rosters typically involve state schools such as Riverside High, Exeter High, Kings Meadows High etc. as well as the Independent schools in Launceston.



BASKETBALL NSATIS TERM ONE

NSATIS Senior Basketball (Boys & Girls)

- Played mostly on Wednesdays after school with a few Monday afternoon matches (times do vary between 3:00, 3:30, 4:15 and 5:15). The roster involves one weekend where games are held on Saturday.
- Rosters are drawn up before the season commences and are available on the SATIS
 website. LCS produces a copy which just has the LCS team info on it so you can stick
 it on your fridge!
- Separate Boys and Girls rosters
- Matches will be at LCS or the opposing schools court with a couple of games to be played @ Elphin Sports Centre.
- Open to all Year 7-12 students, although the 1sts usually involve the Year 10 12 students. But this doesn't disqualify younger players for trying out to make the teams. Independent umpires will officiate the matches. Schools are required to provide a scorekeeper.
- There are usually 3 divisions. Senior 1sts, 2nds and 3rds. When LCS only has one team they will be entered into the 1sts with subsequent teams entered into lower divisions.
- Includes trips to Burnie and Devonport for the Senior. 1sts teams. These require students to leave school at lunchtime and will mean a late arrival home (usually around 8pm).
- The majority of games are out of school hours but when LCS hosts Marist and St. Brendan's the tip-off is at 3:00. In situations where students miss out on class time they are expected to catch up on the work they missed out on.
- Uniform: Plain black shorts and LCS issued Maroon basketball singlet (Loan from library)
- Full rosters, ladders, rules and regulations are available on the SATIS website
- Coaches are volunteer staff/parents/senior students and they give up their own time to train and coach these teams.



BASKETBALL NHSSA TERM THREE & FOUR

NHSSA Year 7-10 Basketball (Boys & Girls)


- Played on Thursdays after school (times vary between 4pm, 4:50pm and 5:40pm).
- The competition is divided into Juniors (Year 7 & 8), Seniors (Year 9 & 10)
- Separate Boys and Girls rosters
- Matches will be at LCS or the opposing schools court with some games to be played @ Elphin Sports Centre.
- Open to all Year 7-10 students.
- Schools are required to provide referees for their home venue and each school is required to provide a scorekeeper who should sit together on the score bench.
- There are usually 2 divisions in each age group. 1sts, 2nds.
- Uniform: Plain black shorts and LCS issued Maroon basketball singlet (Loan from library)
- Rosters, ladders, rules and regulations are available on the NHSSA website.
- Coaches are volunteer staff/parents/senior students and give up their own time to train and coach these teams.



TABLE TENNIS NSATIS TERM ONE

NSATIS Year 7-10 Table Tennis (Boys & Girls)

- Played on Tuesday afternoons at 4:15pm
- All matches are at Elphin Sports Centre
- If there are enough teams then there will be 2 divisions.
- Format requires teams of 4 (can be a mix of genders and ages) and players play a range of singles and doubles matches with all results contributing to the team score.
- Scoring of matches is done by the players who aren't playing
 Full rosters, ladders, rules and regulations are available on the SATIS website
- Coaches are volunteer staff/parents/senior students and give up their own time to train and coach these teams.




BADMINTON NSATIS TERM TWO & THREE

- Played on Monday afternoons at 4:00pm.
- There will be home and away matches.
 2018 was the first year LCS entered into this competition and the team was successful in taking out the title!
- Teams consist of 8 members (4 Boys and 4 Girls)
 1st and 2nd division are available but LCS are expected to field a 1sts team before entering a 2nds team.




NETBALL

NHSSA TERM TWO & THREE

NHSSA Year 7-12 Saturday morning netball (Girls)


- Played on Saturday mornings (times vary between 8am, 9am and 10am).
 The competition is divided into Juniors (Year 7 & 8), Seniors (Year 9 & 10) and Year 11 & 12.
- We keep students in year groups as that's the way the divisions used to be organised. This year we will investigate making teams based on ability.
- Matches will be at Hoblers Bridge Rd
- Open to all Year 7-12 Girls.
- Schools are required to provide an umpire each and each school is required to provide a scorekeeper who should sit together on the sidelines.
- Uniform: LCS Netball Dress (Loan from library)
- Rosters, ladders, rules and regulations are available on the NHSSA website.
- Coaches are volunteer staff/parents/senior students and give up their own time to train and coach these teams.



NETBALL NSATIS TERM THREE

NSATIS Netball (Girls)

- 2018 was our inaugural year in the NSATIS Senior 1sts netball competition. The level
 of competition was very high but the LCS girls team did a great job representing our
 school. In 2021 we will be playing in the 2nds competition.
- Played mostly on Wednesdays after school with a few Monday afternoon matches (times do vary between 3:00, 3:30, 4:15 and 5:15). Launceston schools sometimes play early on a Saturday morning but if we have a team LCS will be requesting to keep the games to Mondays and Wednesdays.
- Rosters are drawn up before the season commences and are available on the SATIS
 website. LCS also produces a copy which just has the LCS team info on it so you can
 stick it on your fridge!
- Matches will be at LCS or the opposing schools court
- Open to all Year 7-12 students, although the 1sts usually involve the Year 10 12 students. But this doesn't disqualify younger players for trying out to make the teams.
- Independent umpires will officiate the matches. Schools are required to provide a scorekeeper each.
- There are usually 2 divisions. Snr. 1sts, 2nds. When LCS only has one team they will be entered into the 1sts with subsequent teams entered into lower divisions.
- Includes trips to Burnie and Devonport for the Senior 1sts team. These require students to leave school at lunchtime and will mean a late arrival home (usually around 8pm).
- The majority of games are out of school hours but when LCS hosts Marist and St. Brendan's the games start at 3:00. In situations where students miss out on class time they are expected to catch up on the work they missed out on.
- Uniform: LCS netball dress (Loan from library)
- Full rosters, ladders, rules and regulations are available on the SATIS website
- Coaches are volunteer staff/parents/senior students and give up their own time to train and coach these teams.



CARNIVALS

NSATIS Carnivals (Swimming, Cross Country, Athletics)

- The 3 NSATIS carnivals will involve a team of LCS Year 7 12 students. Students will
 be selected based on their performance at our 3 school carnivals. Team selection
 takes into account individual results at our carnival, student workload and student
 preference. When selected to represent LCS at the NSATIS carnivals students are
 expected to participate to the best of their ability in the events they have been
 selected in.

NSATIS Junior Soccer (Boys & Girls)


- Played on Friday afternoons at 4:00pm
- Open to Year 7 & 8 students
- Separate Boys and Girls rosters
- Rosters are drawn up before the season commences and are available on the SATIS
 website. LCS also produces a copy which just has the LCS team info on it so you can
 stick it on your fridge!
- Played at Launceston school soccer grounds (LCS uses the council grounds @ the Windsor Precinct as our home ground)
- Only involves the Launceston based independent schools (LCS, Scotch, Grammar & St. Pats)
- Home team provides central referee and each team provides a linesman.
- Uniform: School soccer top (Loan from the library). Plain Black shorts, Plain Black Socks, Shin Pads, Goalkeeper gloves and soccer boots are all the responsibility of the players to provide.
- Full rosters, ladders, rules and regulations are available on the SATIS website
- Coaches are volunteer staff/parents/senior students and give up their own time to train and coach these teams.



SOCCER NSATIS TERM THREE

NSATIS Senior Soccer (Boys & Girls)

- Matches for the Senior 1sts teams are played on Monday and Wednesdays after school. Senior 2nds matches are played on Saturday mornings.
- Rosters are drawn up before the season commences and are available on the SATIS
 website. LCS also produces a copy which just has the LCS team info on it so you can
 stick it on your fridge!
- Separate Boys and Girls rosters
- Matches will be played at the school soccer grounds (LCS uses our oval and Riverside Olympic when hosting home games so the boys and girls matches can be played simultaneously)
- Open to all Year 7-12 students, although the 1sts usually involve the Year 10 12 students. But this doesn't disqualify younger players for trying out to make the teams.
- Independent referees will officiate the matches. Schools are required to provide a linesman.
- There are usually 2 divisions. Senior 1sts, 2nds. When LCS only has one team they will be entered into the 1sts with subsequent teams entered into the 2nds.
- Includes trips to Burnie and Devonport for the Snr. 1sts teams. These require students to leave school at lunchtime and will mean a late arrival home (usually around 8pm).
- The majority of games are out of school hours but due to limited daylight hours in winter the games must start by 4:00. This will require team members to leave school at 3:00 to ensure they get to the venues on time.
- Uniform: Plain black SHORTS & SOCKS and LCS issued soccer top (Loan from library).
- Full rosters, ladders, rules and regulations are available on the SATIS website
- Coaches are volunteer staff/parents/senior students and give up their own time to train and coach these teams.



CRICKET

NSATIS TERM ONE & FOUR

NSATIS Junior Cricket (Yr. 7/8 Boys & Girls)

- We hope to include this for the first time in 2021
- Played on Saturday mornings from 8:30-12:30
- Played at LCS, SPC, Grammar and SOC
- Year 7 competition and a Year 8 competition, but if numbers are low they can be combined.
- Mixed teams of boys are girls are OK
- 11 Players per team
- Each team must provide an umpire and a scorer and have adult team supervision

NHSSA Year 9-10


- T20 format and played over Terms 1&4.

- Glenorchy, HobartRaces are in age groups ranging from Year 12 down to Year 7.


